

**The list of road border crossing points across the state frontier
where the procedure of affixing and removal of electronic seals is carried out**

1. Torfyanovka (Leningrad Region, Vyborg District, Torfyanovka village)
2. Brusnichnoe (Leningrad Region, Vyborg District, Seleznevskaya volost, 71 km of Zverevo-Malinovka road, facility without number.)
3. Burachki (Pskov Region, Sebezhsy District, urban settlement "Sosnovy Bor", Burachki village, 300 m to the North-West, facility without number.)
4. Ubylinka (Pskov Region, Pytalovsky District, village settlement "Gavrovskaya volost", Ubolenka village, facility without number.)
5. Krupets (Kursk Region, Rylsky District, within the boundaries of the municipal settlement "Kozinsky village council")
6. Sudzha (Kursk Region., Sudzhansky District, Zaoleshensky village council)
7. Troebortnoe (Bryansk Region, Sevsky District, 518 km. (+580 m), road "Ukraine")
8. Nekhoteevka (Belgorod Region, Belgorodsky District, 705 km. of the federal road Moscow-Simferopol)
9. Novye Yurkovichi (Bryansk Region, Klimovsky District)
10. Ivangorod (Leningrad Region, Ivangorod town, 4, Kingiseppskoe highway)
11. Krasnoe (M-1 highway "Belarus" – from Moscow to the border with the Republic of Belarus, 456 km.)
12. Rudnya (A-141 highway (P-120) "Orel – Bryansk - Smolensk" – the border with the Republic of Belarus, 448 km.)
13. Krasny Kamen (A-240 (M13) highway "Bryansk - Novozybkov" - the border with the Republic of Belarus, 220 km.)
14. Mashtakovo (Orenburg Region, Pervomaisky District, the 194th km. of the A-300 highway "Samara – Bolshaya Chernigovka" – the border with the Republic of Kazakhstan)
15. Bugristoe (Chelyabinsk Region, Troitsky District, Bugristoe village, A-310 highway «Ekaterinburg – Almaty, 147 km)
16. Petukhovo (Kurgan Region, Petukhovskiy District, 464 km of the P-254 highway "Irtysh", International automobile border crossing point "Petukhovo". Operational services building, building No. 30 according to the plan, office 18)
17. Veloyarsk (A-322 highway "Barnaul – Rubtsovsk – the border with the Republic of Kazakhstan", 404 km)
18. Kyakhta (the Republic of Buryatiya, Kyakhtinsky District, Kyakhta town, 1, Tamozhennaya str.)
19. Verkhny Lars (the Republic of North Ossetia-Alania, Vladikavkaz, Verkhny Lars village)
20. Yagar-Kazmalyar (the Republic of Dagestan, Magaramkentsky District, Yagar-Kazmalyar village, building No. 3)

**Guide for road transport operators:
“Necessary steps for the transit of sanctioned goods through the territory of Russia to third
countries using electronic navigation seals”¹**

Registration of the transport operator in the system

To carry out the transportation of sanctioned goods, it is necessary to register in the e-seal operator's system. Transport operators can register in the system of the “Digital Platforms Development Center LLC” free of charge.

The list of information to be provided by the transport operator in order to receive the company's services depends on the type of service required, and may depend on the transport operator, consignor/consignee and transportation details.

It is possible to register in the system:

- on the website through the personal account section <https://transit.crmp.ru/login>
- in the agencies located at border-crossing points across the Russian Federation and stationary checkpoints.

Creation of a request for the provision of an e-seal operator's services

When carrying out the transportation of sanctioned goods, the transport operator must provide the e-seal operator with all the data details of which are contained in the list published by the Ministry of Transport of the Russian Federation on the official website, no later than 2 hours before arriving at either the border-crossing point of the Russian Federation, or a stationary or mobile checkpoint, indicating the requested information.

The submission of the required information to the e-seal operator will be considered a request for their services.

Information that the transport operator must provide to the e-seal operator:

- Name of the transport operator;
- Type, country of registration and registration plate of the vehicle, trailer or semi-trailer;
- Email address and mobile phone number of the driver of the vehicle;
- Codes of the transported goods in accordance with the TNVED (HS codes applicable in the Eurasian Economic Union), in the format of at least 10 digits;
- Country of origin of the goods transported;
- Country of departure of the goods transported;
- Country of destination of the goods transported;
- The planned date of entry into the territory of the Russian Federation;
- The planned date of departure from the territory of the Russian Federation;
- Border-crossing point of the Russian Federation when entering the territory of the Russian Federation;
- Border-crossing point of the Russian Federation when leaving the territory of the Russian Federation;
- Number of required electronic navigation seals.

Conclusion of a contract for the provision of services

When the transport operator requests the services of an e-seal operator, an agreement for the provision of services shall be established with him.

When placing an order on the website, the transport operator must agree payment terms, which the system will request.

If the transport operator requests the service at an agency, the employee of the e-seal operator will prepare a paper contract for the provision of paid services, which must be signed by the transport operator.

Mandatory payments for the use of electronic navigation seals

Payment for the e-seal operator's services must be made in advance, prior to the actual provision of services, in accordance with the placed order.

Payment can be made by credit card on the website or in person at the agency, as well as by bank transfer using details provided by the e-seal operator.

Entry through the border-crossing point of the Russian Federation, or checkpoints

After entry into the territory of the Russian Federation of a road vehicle used in the transportation of sanctioned goods, a decision on the use, application and activation of the electronic navigation seals is made by either a customs official at the border-crossing point or an official of the Federal Service for the Supervision of Transport in stationary and mobile checkpoints, following document checks.

After the appropriate decisions have been taken, an authorised e-seal operator employee draws up an ENS (electronic navigation seal) issuance certificate and creates a registration coupon for the road transport.

After the paperwork is completed, the e-seal operator employee performs the application of the ENS and its activation in the system.

Departure from the Russian Federation through checkpoints

When a road vehicle leaves the territory of the Russian Federation, a customs authority official at the border-crossing point of the Russian Federation, or a Federal Service for Supervision of Transport official in a stationary or mobile checkpoint, makes a decision to deactivate the electronic navigation seals, as well as informs the e-seal operator of the delivery of the registration coupon by the driver of the vehicle. An authorised e-seal operator employee removes and deactivates the electronic navigation seal in the system.

The transport operator must pass the registration coupon to the official.

When leaving the territory of the Russian Federation, the e-seal operator checks the integrity of the electronic navigation seal generates and signs the act of returning the ENS.
